2020 Initiatives

Despite headwinds, significant strides were made in 2020.

You can now find IEF on the Indiana State Library's Indiana Memory project. Alongside dozens of libraries and history organizations, you can browse a folder of Hoosier entertainment history which is globally searchable. Initial entries include rare photos of 1940's and 1950's country musicians taken mostly at Indiana radio stations, including WIBC in Indianapolis and WJOB in Hammond.

The Indiana Historical Society digitized more than 200 posters and flyers from our collection of Indiana concerts of the 1970's and 1980's as part of its Indianapolis Bicentennial Exhibit. Executive Director Rick Wilkerson served on the Community Advisory Council for this exhibit and the Starr-Gennett "You Are There" exhibit.

We received a grant from Indiana Historical Society's Heritage Support Grants for a laptop and DSLR camera to aid in digitizing our collections (and perhaps yours someday?) in order to add important images to the Memory Project and to other IEF initiatives. Heritage Support Grants are provided by the Indiana Historical Society and made possible by Lilly Endowment, Inc.

IEF is now an approved nonprofit for Lilly Endowment; employees and retirees can donate stock via the quarterly matching program. You can donate stock from any company here.

The Indiana Music Virtual History Museum (IMVHM) is under construction and

will launch in early 2021 for your input and browsing pleasure; you will have opportunity to add listings, information, memories, and images. The IMVHM's mission is to exhaustively document local music history, with listings for artists, musicians, releases, record labels, venues, promoters, record stores. music stores, and more. If you have already volunteered to help, you will hear from us soon.

Speaking of promoters, 2020 saw the emergence of the Indiana Rock History

project from Steve Sybesma, former Sunshine Promotions partner. Indiana Rock History is documenting concerts that happened in Indiana, and no one is more qualified to do so than Steve, as Sunshine promoted more than 2000 shows in the Hoosier state beginning in the early 1970's. We welcome their efforts and collaborative spirit and hope you will enjoy their work. IEF would not be possible without the support of the board, staff, volunteers,

donors, charter members, and you! Thank you for your interest in our entertainment history. We offer you an early toast to the upcoming new year.


